

Name of Material: Kdg Tools of the Mind Sound Maps (Consonant, Vowel, Digraph)

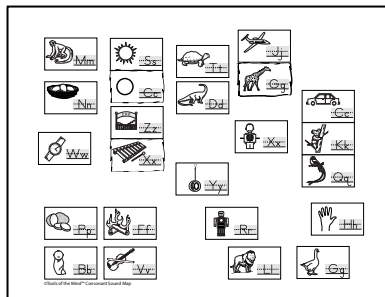
Assembly/printing instructions: Print Sound Maps double sided (Consonants on one side and Vowel/Digraphs on the other). Print enough Sound Maps so that children have access to them whenever they are doing Scaffolded Writing. Every 2-3 children should have one map.

Activities this material is used in:

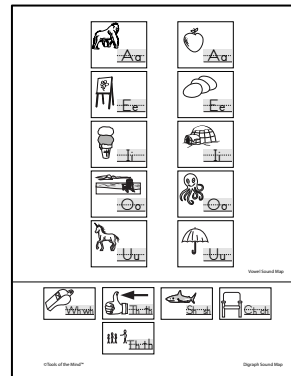
All Scaffolded Writing activities throughout the school year.

Additional Information: Many teachers print one Consonant Sound Map on larger paper for use in Teacher Directed Shared Scaffolded Writing with the entire classroom. Many teachers also print extra Sound Maps and place them in each of the centers so children always have them accessible for writing. If you are unable to print double sided, you can print single sided.
